

## Guidelines and Expectations for Students Requesting High School Language Credit

Many area high schools grant language credit to students studying Hebrew at Akiva. In order to maintain the high level of learning which this relationship requires, we will adhere to the following guidelines and expectations:

1. Students must attend 85% of class sessions.  
*There is no substitute for in-class study and participation when it comes to learning a language. Recognizing that our students are busy, we do offer tutoring for students who attend less than the required number of classes.  
Attendance constitutes 25% of a student's final grade.*
2. A passing grade in all unit tests must be achieved.  
*Unit tests constitute 25% of the student's final grade.*
3. Full participation in classroom activities including quizzes and homework, and attendance at enrichment programs.  
*Participation, quizzes and homework and attendance at enrichment programs constitute 50% of the student's final grade.*
